## VOLUNTEER PROJECT

OAM's Volunteer Project for Spring 2021 will not be the usual run/walk but will provide an opportunity for us to serve those in need. The 2021 Spring Volunteer Project is the Good Neighbor House in Dayton, Ohio. This organization is working to improve the lives of people in need by providing accessible health care and nutritional care. Neighbors can find help in the dental clinic, medical clinic, eye clinic, food pantry, counseling, or affiliated programs. In 2020, in the midst of shutdowns and impact to services, the medical, eye, and associated clinics had about 500 visits. The food pantry had about 30,000 visits, and the dental clinic had around 2,000 visits. After a charitable clinic closed their doors in the midst of the pandemic, Good Neighbor House began operating a pharmaceutical dispensary, physical therapy, and behavioral health clinics. The dispensary has been a massive help for their patients, growing the number of prescriptions they could fill from five per month to over 100. In the first six months, they distributed just under 1,000 prescriptions.

We encourage all of you to continue the good energy and good will created last Fall with your donations to the Columbus Diaper Bank. This is your opportunity to volunteer by donating to a great project and to have a real impact on the lives of the community members serviced by Good Neighbor House. In the past, for your \$20 donation, you received a t-shirt. As in the Fall, we will not provide t-shirts but instead donate the cost of the t-shirts to the Good Neighbor House in addition to our total donations.


